# **APPLYING**

Students are invited to fill out an electronic or paper application form, which is available online at greatplainscollege.ca/apply, or at any Great Plains College location. Students must pay the \$55 application fee and submit their most current transcripts for their application to be considered.

### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

Entrance Scholarships of \$500 are available for fulltime students in all post-secondary programs. Gradebased Entrance Scholarships\* up to a maximum total of \$5,000 are available for students in the Administrative Assistant, Business, Bachelor of Social Work, Electrician, Liberal Arts Certificate, University, Welding and Youth Care Worker programs.


Grade 11 students who apply to a full-time student loan-eligible program and have at least a 70% average (based on four core courses) are eligible for an additional Early Entrance Award of \$1,000.

#### Deadlines:

- > Apr 30—\$500-\$5,000 Entrance Scholarship (September entry)
- > Oct 31— \$500-\$5,000 Entrance Scholarship (Late fall and winter entry)
- > June 30—\$1,000 Early Entrance Award (Gr. 11)

\*Entrance Scholarship grade average is calculated based on marks from 30-level Canadian studies and English classes, and the highest achieved marks from 20 or 30-level math and science classes. Some exceptions may apply.
