Janitorial Level 1

LEVEL: 1

FUNCTION: JANITORIAL

JOB SUMMARY

This position is primarily responsible for cleaning of College facilities.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- All cleaning (including but not limited to dusting, vacuuming, washing floors walls and windows, waxing floors, cleaning furniture, appliances & computers) in classrooms, bathrooms, offices, common areas and kitchen/coffee rooms
- Garbage disposal
- Inventory of cleaning supplies
- Reporting maintenance problems

CONTACTS

The majority of contacts within this position require the exchange of basic factual information. (Level 1)

Typical contacts may include:

- College staff
- Students

SCOPE OF DECISION MAKING

The majority of decisions within this position require interpretation within a range of established alternatives. Direction is sought when solutions are not within established guidelines. (Level 2)

Typical decisions may include:

- Determine a cleaning schedule
- Determine maintenance problems and who to report them to
- Determine cleaning supplies that are required

IMPACT OF DECISION MAKING

The majority of decisions have short-term impact limited to the single work area. (Level 1)

MENTAL EFFORT

The majority of tasks within this position are standardized utilizing information that is given and requires no interpretation. (Level 1)

Typical tasks may include:

- Vacuuming
- Dusting
- Washing walls and floors
- Requesting cleaning supplies

SENSORY EFFORT

Sensory tasks within this position require minimal visual or aural attention. (Level 1)

Typical tasks may include:

- Examining and checking areas to be cleaned
- Completing inventory of supplies

SUPERVISION

Supervisory responsibility is not normally part of the job requirement. There may be a requirement to show others how to perform tasks or duties. (Level 1)

PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

The physical activity within this position requires frequent heavy activity (greater than 20 % of the time). (Level 3)

FINE MOTOR MOVEMENT

The duties within this position requiring the use of fine motor movements are less than 20%. (Level 1)

Typical tasks may include:

- Writing
- Use of small hand tools

TRAVEL

The travel within this position is slight (less than 5% of work time). (Level 1)

CONTROL OF DISTRACTIONS

This position usually has the discretion to limit distractions/interruptions. (Level 1)

EDUCATION

The minimum relevant knowledge or formal training required to perform the functions of the job is up to and including completion of grade 12 or equivalent. (Level 1)

EXPERIENCE

The minimum amount of practical related experience required to perform the duties of this position is less than one year. (Level 1)
