

Spring is on the horizon and the deadlines for our Entrance Scholarships and Early Entrance Awards are on the radar. Additional information about programs, events and scholarships can be found at greatplainscollege.ca.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

Students are automatically considered for an Entrance Scholarship or Early Entrance Award when they apply to a full-time student loan-eligible program before the scholarship deadline (see below). They must pay the \$55 application fee and submit their most current transcripts for their application to be considered.

ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS – \$500-\$5,000 DEADLINE: APRIL 30, 2017

Entrance Scholarships of \$500 are available for the Certificate in Health Safety and Environmental Processes, Power Engineering (Third and Fourth Class), Practical Nursing and Registered Nursing programs.

Graded-based scholarships up to a maximum total of \$5,000 are available for students in Administrative Assistant, Bachelor of Social Work, Business, Electrician, Liberal Arts Certificate, University*, Welding and Youth Care Worker.

*Students enrolled in University through Great Plains College are eligible for scholarships from their university of study as well.

EARLY ENTRANCE AWARD DEADLINE - \$1,000 DEADLINE: JUNE 30, 2017

Early Entrance Awards of \$1,000 are available for students in Grade 11 with at least a 70 per cent average (based on four core classes). They must apply to full-time student loan-eligible program.
