CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

As a boom truck and crane and hoist operator you will lift, move, position or place machinery, equipment and other large objects at construction or industrial sites, ports, railway yards, surface mines and other similar locations.

As a graduate of this pre-employment certificate program, you will be prepared for employment with construction, industrial, mining, cargo handling and railway companies.

EARNING POTENTIAL

In 2016, the average annual salary for full-time crane operators in Saskatchewan was \$90,900, according to the Saskatchewan Ministry of the Economy. Employees may earn more or less depending on their employer, location, size of company, apprenticeship training, experience and hours worked.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

In less than three months, get the skills you need to begin your career as an operator. Work in high-paying industries such as heavy construction, mining, oil and gas, which require crane and hoisting operations.

Through Great Plains College, you will receive the Western Trade Training Institute (WTTI) industry training required to advance in your chosen field. Upon successful completion of this program you may be granted trade time and academic credit when you find employment in the trade and register in either boom truck or mobile crane operator apprenticeships streams.

This certificate program includes a two-week work placement.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 10
- 18 years of age or older
- Physical suitability
- Valid Class 5 driver's licence
