RECRUITMENT

We are pleased to introduce you to Breena McInnis, recruitment assistant, new to our Great Plains College recruitment team. APPLYING

Students are invited to fill out an electronic or paper application form, which is available online at greatplainscollege.ca/apply, or at any Great Plains College location. Students must pay the \$55 application fee and submit their most current transcripts for their application to be considered.

MATERIALS

In the coming days, your school will receive an information package. Updated materials include the 2018-19 program guide, Spend-A-Day and Open House details and scholarship information.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Entrance Scholarships of \$500 are available for students applying to full-time student-loan eligible programs. Grade-based Entrance Scholarships* up to a maximum total of \$5,000 are available for students in the Administrative Assistant, Business (certificate and Human Resources or Management diploma), Electrician, Power Engineering, University, Welding and Youth Care Worker programs.

Grade 11 students who apply to a full-time student loan-eligible program and have at least a 70% average (based on four core courses) are eligible for an additional Early Entrance Award of \$1,000.

Deadlines:

- > Apr 30—\$500-\$5,000 Entrance Scholarship (September start dates)
- > Oct 31— \$500-\$5,000 Entrance Scholarship (Late fall and winter entry)
- > June 30—\$1,000 Early Entrance Award (Gr. 11)

*Entrance Scholarship grade average is calculated based on marks from 30-level Canadian studies and English classes, and the highest achieved marks from 20 or 30-level math and science classes. Some exceptions may apply.
