SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

Students are automatically considered for an Entrance Scholarship or Early Entrance Award when they apply to a full-time student loan-eligible program.

ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS – \$500-\$5,000 DEADLINE: APRIL 30, 2018

Entrance Scholarships of \$500 are available for the Certificate in Health Safety and Environmental Processes, Diploma in Safety, Health and Environmental Management and Practical Nursing.

Grade-based scholarships up to a maximum total of \$5,000 are available for students in Administrative Assistant, Business (certificate and Human Resources or Management diploma), Electrician, Power Engineering, University, Welding and Youth Care Worker programs.

*Students enrolled in University through Great Plains College are eligible for scholarships from their university of study as well.

EARLY ENTRANCE AWARD – \$1,000 DEADLINE: JUNE 30, 2017

Early Entrance Awards of \$1,000 are available for students in Grade 11 with at least a 70 per cent average (based on four core classes) applying to a full-time student loan-eligible program.

NEW AWARD: INNOVATION CREDIT UNION COMMUNITY INNOVATOR AWARD

Students enrolled in a full-time student loan eligible program are invited to submit innovative and implementable community engagement ideas. Up to two awards of \$2,000 each will be provided to applicants who contribute their ideas. Deadline to apply: April 30, 2018
