EARNING POTENTIAL

In 2016, the average annual salary for full-time accounting and related clerks in Saskatchewan was \$47.800. Financial auditors and accountants average full-time salary was \$72,800, according to the Saskatchewan Ministry of the Economy. The average annual salary range for full-time human resources and recruitment officers and professionals in Saskatchewan was \$54,300-\$69,300. And, the average annual salary range for data entry, personnel and general office clerks and administrative and executive assistants in Saskatchewan was \$46,400-\$68,900.

Employees may earn more or less depending on their employer, location, size of company, training, experience and hours worked.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 12 with any 30-level math
- Computer experience using Windows applications is recommended.
- Minimum English Language Requirement- International English Language Testing System (IELTS) overall minimum score of Band 6.5 with minimum of 6.0 in each component
- A \$125 CAD non-refundable application fee payable to Great Plains College is required for an application to be considered.
- International students must successfully attain a valid study permit to study in Canada. As of March 1, 2018, applicants who provide a Guaranteed Investment Certificate (GIC) of \$10,000 as proof of ability to self-support and provide proof of tuition payment for their first year may have their study permit application expedited.
