WHY THE LIBERAL ARTS CERTIFICATE?

The Liberal Arts Certificate is a flexible program, both in content and in delivery model. It allows students to:

- Take the first year of university studies while remaining in a smaller city
- Take introductory university classes in comfortable class sizes that offer a more personal, supportive and productive learning environment
- Begin full-time or part-time studies with a defined academic goal in sight
- Complete a university program that may or may not have begun at a different post-secondary institution (up to 15 credits may be non-University of Regina courses)

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

The Liberal Arts Certificate is a flexible program, where you will be introduced to a wide range of university subjects and courses that are general to all walks of life, rather than specific to a particular profession or trade.

The completion of this program can function as a standalone certificate or as the first step towards many university degrees.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS



SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBLE

Apply as a full-time student before April 30 and you may be eligible for a \$500-\$5,000 Entrance Scholarship. If you are in Grade 11 and have at least a 70% average, apply by June 30 and you are eligible for a \$1,000 Early Entrance Award.
