

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

As a graduate, you may find employment in medical, surgical, maternalchild or pediatric units at acute care hospitals, rehabilitation or palliative care units, medical centres, community and home care facilities and extended care facilities.

EARNING POTENTIAL

In 2016, the average annual salary for full-time licensed practical nurses in Saskatchewan was \$59,200, according to the Saskatchewan Ministry of the Economy. Employees may earn more or less depending on their employer, location, training, experience and hours worked.

Demand for health care workers will continue to rise as Saskatchewan's population ages in the coming years.

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WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Receive the training required to write the exam to become a licensed practical nurse in Saskatchewan. Through a combination of hands-on classroom learning and practicums, you will receive clinical experience in medicine, surgery, pharmacology, acute care, obstetrics, pediatrics, longterm and rehabilitative care, health promotion and illness prevention. You will be highly skilled and well prepared to write your licensure exam upon graduation.

At Swift Current Campus, the Practical Nursing program starts in September. At Biggar Program Centre, the Practical Nursing Program starts in February. This program is full-time.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

• Grade 12 with a minimum overall average of 65% in the following five subjects: English Language Arts A30; English Language Arts B30; one of Foundations of Math 30, Workplace and Apprenticeship Math, or Pre-Calculus 30; one of Biology 30, Chemistry 30, or Physics 30; and one of Social Studies 30, History 30, or Native Studies 30

- English language requirement (specific to Practical Nursing)
- · Up-to-date immunization record*
- Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector checks*
- Current Standard First Aid, CPR Heartsaver 'C' AED and Health Care Provider or equivalent*
- Transferring, Lifting and Repositioning (TLR) certification*
- 2015 WHMIS

This program follows a high demand intake process. Please contact a student adviser to confirm application deadlines.

*Required upon admission to the program.

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SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBLE

Apply before April 30 for the Swift Current program, or before October 31 for the Biggar program, and you are eligible for a \$500 Entrance Scholarship.

If you are in Grade 11 and have at least a 70% average, apply before June 30 and you are eligible for a \$1,000 Early Entrance Award.
