You can build your employability skills through the Pre-12 Basic Education program. This adult-focused program is flexible and designed to meet you at your current learning level and needs.

The program focuses on giving you the knowledge and life-skills you need to get and keep a job. When you are ready, you will have the option to continue your education and complete your Grade 12.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

The Pre-12 program is for students who haven't completed high school. Through this program you will have the opportunity to complete high school credits and improve your ability to work with numbers, communicate and read and write.

In addition to academic studies, you will also participate in a number of employment and life-skills lessons. Our staff and instructors know that sometimes life's up and downs can get in the way of education. FINANCIAL AID

These are secondary programs and are not eligible for student loans consideration or Great Plains College Entrance Scholarships, however \$1,000 Adult Basic Education Persistence Awards are available to recognize students who've demonstrated perseverance in order to continue with their formal education.
