

WHAT IS SOCIAL WORK?

You will gain the skills necessary to counsel individuals and groups, develop and administer programs, empower community groups, conduct social research, analyze programs, policies and issues and develop and implement problem-solving strategies. The program is generalist in approach and will prepare you to work with minority and disadvantaged groups in urban, rural and remote areas.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

 Pre-Social Work (year 1) — Gr. 12 with 70% in five required subjects; English language arts A30 & B30; 30-level math or science; 30-level social science, language or fine arts; and an approved additional 30-level course

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBLE

You will be eligible for scholarships from your university of study and from Great Plains College. Apply to Great Plains College as a full-time student before April 30 for September entry, or October 31 for January entry and you may be eligible for a \$500-\$5,000 Entrance Scholarship.

Apply before June 30—if you are in Grade 11 and have a 70% average and you may be eligible for a \$1,000 Early Entrance Award.

COURSE LIST

This program consists of 60 credit hours of general university studies, 39 credit hours of Social Work studies and two practicums consisting of 21 credit hours. Courses for this program are delivered in the classroom, by video conference and online.

APPLICATION PROCESS

YEAR 1:

Contact a Great Plains College student adviser and they will work with you to complete the U of R undergraduate application for Pre-Social Work. You must also apply to Great Plains College.

YEAR 2:

Apply to the U of R through the Bachelor of Social Work application process.
