



# WHAT IS PRE-NURSING?

Students interested in obtaining a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) from the University of Saskatchewan can take their first year, 30 credit hours, of pre-professional Arts and Science courses at Great Plains College.

## **ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS**

• Students must be enrolled at either the University of Saskatchewan or the University of Regina to take University classes at Great Plains College

## SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBLE

You will be eligible for scholarships from your university of study and from Great Plains College. Students must be taking a full-time course load that is student loan-eligible to qualify for scholarship consideration at Great Plains College.

Apply to Great Plains College as a full-time student before April 30 for September entry, or October 31 for January entry and you may be eligible for a \$500-\$5,000 Entrance Scholarship. Apply before June 30—if you are in Grade 11 and have a 70% average and you may be eligible for a \$1,000 Early Entrance Award.

### **COURSE LIST**

The pre-professional year of study requires the completion of 30 credit hours of University courses. A suggested course schedule that meets the Pre-Nursing requirements include:

#### FALL: September-December

- BIOL 100 Introductory Biology I
- CHEM 104 General Chemistry I
- ENGL 100 Critical Reading and Writing I
- SOC 100 Introduction to Sociology OR

- PSYC 102 Introduction to Psychology B
- Approved elective

### WINTER: January-April

- BIOL 101 Introductory Biology II or Approved Elective
- INDG 100 Introduction to Indigenous Studies
- NUTR 120 Basic Nutrition (online)
- PSYC 101 Introduction to Psychology A
- STAT 120 Business Statistics
