

ADULT BASIC EDUCATION (ABE) PERSISTENCE AWARD

About the Award

The ABE Persistence Award is designed to recognize the perseverance of ABE students who are registered full-time in the Adult Basic Education program (Adult 10, Grade 12 or Upgrading only) at Great Plains College. Students must be enrolled full-time in the ABE program at one of our four locations (Martensville, Kindersley, Swift Current, Maple Creek) and demonstrate their dedication to pursuing post-secondary education.

A total of eight (8) awards will be presented in the 2020-21 academic year for students enrolled full-time in either the Adult 10, Grade 12 of Upgrading programs. Awards will be distributed as follows at each campus:

- Martensville One (1) \$1,000 award and one (1) \$500 award
- Kindersley One (1) \$1,000 award and one (1) \$500 award
- Swift Current- One (1) \$1,000 award and one (1) \$500 award
- Maple Creek One (1) \$1,000 award and one (1) \$500 award

Great Plains College will base its selection of the awards to candidates on the eligibility criteria below.

Eligibility*

To be eligible, applicants must be currently enrolled full-time in the Great Plains College Adult Basic Education program, in either Adult 10, Grade 12 or Upgrading.

Applicants must demonstrate that, through personal determination, they have managed to overcome barriers in order to continue with their formal education. Applicants will provide a brief statement of 750 words that describes the struggles and obstacles they have overcome in order to pursue formal education in the ABE program. The barriers can be social, family-related, financial etc. Applicants will also be asked to include their academic and employment goals for the future.

Applicants will also be evaluated on their attendance up to the application deadline date, classroom conduct, and motivation and commitment to their studies.

*Students that have previously received this award are not eligible to apply
