



WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Working one-on-one with youth, graduates of the Youth Care Worker Diploma make a difference in their community. ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Successful completion of the equivalent-to-Saskatchewan Grade 12 diploma with a minimum 60% average. No course mark less than 50%.
- English Language Requirement - IELTS overall score of 6.5 with no bands less than 5.0. Duolingo and other assessments are also accepted.
- A security clearance, personal interview and/or medical may be required for practicum placements.

- A \$125 CAD non-refundable application fee payable to Great Plains College is required for an application to be considered.
- International students must successfully attain a valid study permit to study in Canada. Students from approved countries may apply through the Study Direct Stream.
