



WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

The Liberal Arts Diploma is a flexible program, where you will be introduced to a wide range of university subjects and courses that are general to all walks of life, rather than specific to a particular profession or trade. The Liberal Arts Diploma satisfies the core requirements for the 4-year Bachelor of Arts degree programs at the University of Regina.

The completion of this program can function as a standalone diploma, the first two years of an Arts degree, or as the first step toward many university degrees.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 12
- English language requirement

Please note that if you do not meet these entrance requirements, special admissions options may be available.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBLE

Apply as a full-time student before April 30 and you may be eligible for a \$500-\$5,000 Entrance Scholarship. If you are in Grade 11 and have at least a 70% average, apply by June 30 and you are eligible for a \$1,000 Early Entrance Award.

APPLICATION PROCESS

There is a two-stage application process for a Liberal Arts Diploma:

1. Contact a Great Plains College student adviser and they will work with you to complete the University of Regina undergraduate

application form. You must also apply to Great Plains College.

2. Apply to the University of Regina through the Liberal Arts Diploma application process.

COURSE LIST

This program requires 60 credit hours of university studies. Courses for this diploma program are delivered in the classroom, by live stream and online.

- PSYC 101 - Introductory Psychology A
- WGST 100 - Introduction to Women's and Gender Studies (LIVE)

Students enrolled in the Liberal Arts Diploma are required to declare a minor. A student adviser will work with each student to select their minor and accompanying course load.
