

## WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

This part-time diploma program gives you an understanding of children's varying physical, social, cognitive, creative and emotional development stages and teaches the importance of play as a vehicle for learning.

ECE 106, ECE 142 and HUMD 183 meet the ministry's minimum training requirements for Level 1 certification. Completion of these three courses also qualifies you to receive a Certificate of Achievement from Saskatchewan Polytechnic.

#### **ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- Grade 12 with English Language Arts A30 and B30\*
- English language requirement
- Criminal Record Check, immunization record, Standard First Aid and CPR may all be required prior to practicum.

Please note that if you do not meet the entrance requirements, special admissions options may be available.

\*Grade 12 is not required for Level 1 Early Childhood Education courses, which is a requirement to work in licensed Saskatchewan child care centres.
