



WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Build your employment skills while completing the courses you need to work as an Early Childhood Educator. This program combines essential skills training and Early Childhood Education courses so you'll be ready to start a new career working with children.

Completion of ECE 106, ECE 142 and HUMD 183 meet the Ministry's minimum training requirements for Level 1 Early Childhood Education certification and qualifies you to receive a Certificate of Achievement from Saskatchewan Polytechnic. These three courses are also recognized as dual credit allowing you to simultaneously earn Saskatchewan Polytechnic and Grade 12 credits.

COURSES

Students will improve employment and job search skills through the Essential Skills portion of the program, while also completing the following three Early Childhood education courses:

- ECE 106 - Dynamics of Play 1
- HUMD 183 - Child Guidance 1
- ECE 142 - Health, Safety & Nutrition
