



WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

You will learn skills to work directly with clients in long-term care, home care, assisted living, some areas in acute care, and even special needs classrooms. Theory, hands-on lab and clinical experience is provided. This program focuses on caring for the elderly, but you will be prepared to assist clients of all ages.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must have a successful completion of Secondary education with a minimum average of 60%, and no marks less than 50%.
- Minimum English Language Requirement - International English Language Testing System (IELTS) overall minimum score of Band 6.5 with minimum of 5.0 in each component.
- A \$140 CAD non-refundable application fee payable to Great Plains College is required for an application to be considered.
- Accepted applicants will be required to provide evidence of a current criminal record check from their country of origin.

- Accepted applicants are required to provide current immunization records from birth to present.
- International students must successfully attain a valid study permit to study in Canada. Students from approved countries may apply through the Study Direct Stream. Please note: all transcripts will be sent to the brokering institution, Saskatchewan Polytechnic, for assessment. This may delay the turnaround time for an offer letter. We expect delays to be 15-20 days at a minimum.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

- A copy of blood test results testing for Varicella-zoster Immune status/IgG
- A copy of blood test results testing for Hepatitis B surface antibody (HBsAB)
- Tuberculin skin test completed within the last year or documentation of a previous positive test with a copy of the xray report
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR): documentation proving 2 doses of MMR
- Tdap - IPV
- DTap-IPV-Hib (diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis, inactivated polio and haemophilus influenza type b)
- Pne - C-13 (pneumococcal conjugate 13)
- Rot-5 (rotavirus)
- Hepatitis B: documentation of a 2 to 3 dose Hepatitis B series and a blood test for Hepatitis B surface antibody (HBsAB) that confirms immunity
- Varicella (chickenpox): documentation of 2 doses of Varicella -containing vaccine or a blood test for Varicella- Zoster IgG that confirms immunity
- Polio: documentation of a primary series
- Meningitis: vaccine Men-C-ACYW-135
- HPV-9 vaccine
- Men-C-C vaccine
- Prevnar 13 vaccine
- Influenza: annual immunization is recommended
