



WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of Saskatchewan Polytechnic Youth Care Worker Certificate
- English Language Requirement
- A security clearance, personal interview and/or medical may be required for practicum placements

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBLE

Apply as a full-time student before April 30 and you may be eligible for a \$500–\$5,000 Entrance Scholarship. Apply before June 30—if you are in Grade 11 and have a 70% average and you may be eligible for a \$1,000 Early Entrance Award.
