Great Plains College is looking for LINC Home Study Instructor(s) who are primarily responsible for delivery of a selfpaced distance language training program for eligible immigrants to Canada who are unable to attend classes in person. Eligible immigrants enroll in the program to obtain or improve the English language skills required to function in Canadian society. Instructors deliver weekly instructional sessions by phone or online, as well as monitor and facilitate students' independent study. Instructors work remotely from home.
