The Master of Business Administration in Community Economic Development from Cape Breton University is offered on a part-time basis at Warman Campus. This is a professional program for learners who aspire to play leadership roles in the public sector, third sector organizations and in community-minded businesses. Areas of specialization include strategic leadership, First Nations economic development and public policy.

You will be highly skilled and well prepared to write your licensure exam upon graduation.

LOCATIONS: Biggar, Kindersley, Swift Current

AFTER GPC: Work in acute, rehabilitation, medical centres, extended care or community settings, and choose an area of specialization in facilities across Canada. Continue your education and work toward a degree in Nursing.

BEGIN A CAREER IN OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY (OH&S).

Explore a new learning initiative that focuses on a systems-and process-based approach to Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) concerns and solutions. The COHSES program will focus on improving the ability to identify, prioritize and manage workplace hazards and risks, and provide students with necessary communication considerations to provide leadership guidance on safety, health and environment management issues in a variety of work environments.

CLASSES START: Whenever the time is right for you.

LOCATION: Online

AFTER GPC: A career in Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) can lead to a wide range of opportunities. OH&S professionals are working as health and safety consultants and coordinators, ergonomics and safety specialists, quality assurance professionals, health and safety officers, safety inspectors, occupational hygienists, safety project officers and safety specialists. OH&S professionals may be employed in a wide variety of settings including manufacturing, oil and gas, forestry, mining, construction, government, service and trade sectors.



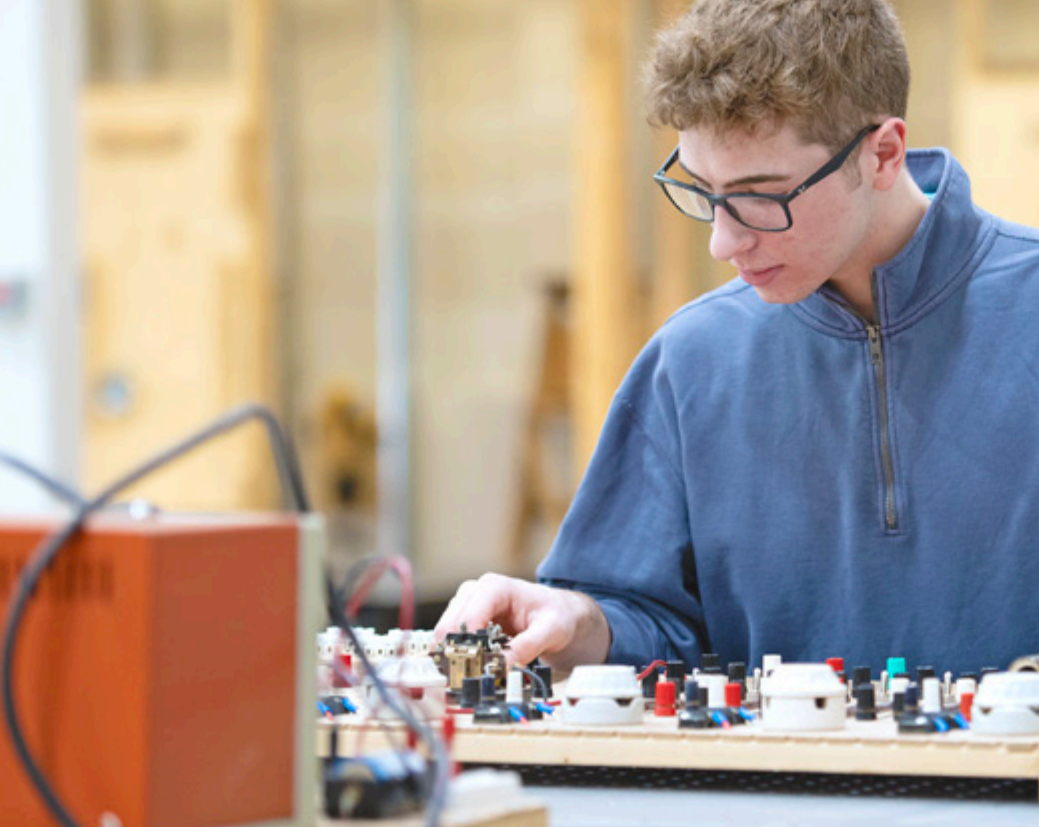

GAIN THE KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED TO DEVELOP, IMPLEMENT AND EVALUATE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY PROGRAMS AND SYSTEMS IN THE WORKPLACE.

Demand for competent health and safety practitioners is increasing steadily and forecasted to accelerate in the future. This program augments the skills and knowledge of graduates of our Certificate in Occupational Health, Safety and Environmental Systems (COHSES) program, or recognized equivalent. Prerequisites for this program are typically met with a University certificate in OH&S studies. Contact us to determine if you may begin the diploma program with pre-existing skills in incident causation theory, risk assessment and physical workplace controls.

CLASSES START: Whenever the time is right for you.

LOCATION: Online

AFTER GPC: Work in a wide variety of sectors as a health and safety consultant or officer, as an ergonomic and safety specialist, quality assurance professional or safety inspector. Pursue a related degree or MBA online.

THIS APPLIED CERTIFICATE PROGRAM PROVIDES ENTRY-LEVEL SKILLS TRAINING TO PREPARE FOR A FAST-TRACK CAREER IN THE ELECTRICAL TRADE.

Electrician is a skilled trade. You'll lay out, assemble, install, test, troubleshoot and repair electrical wiring, fixtures, control devices and related equipment in buildings and structures. Up to 300 hours of trade time and academic credit for Level 1 Apprenticeship may be available to graduates who find employment in the trade and register as apprentices with the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission (SATCC) within the specified timeline.

LOCATION: Swift Current

AFTER GPC: Work with electrical contractors or in maintenance, manufacturing or mining companies. Continue with apprenticeship and earn your journeypersons to increase your earning potential.

THIS SIX-WEEK, INDUSTRY-RECOGNIZED TRAINING WILL PROVIDE POWERED MOBILE EQUIPMENT CERTIFICATION ON TWO PIECES OF HEAVY EQUIPMENT.

Learn operation techniques for two machines in the controlled environment of a virtual simulation lab and on an actual work site. You will operate, observe, learn and practice basic skills required to perform construction tasks. Equipment options may include motor grader, excavator, front-end loader and dozer.

CLASSES START: April or August

LOCATION: Warman

AFTER GPC: Begin working with a construction company, heavy equipment contractor, public works department or mining company. Work toward becoming an independent business owner.

RECEIVE THE TRAINING YOU NEED TO BECOME A LICENSED FOURTH OR THIRD CLASS POWER ENGINEER IN SASKATCHEWAN.

FOURTH CLASS: Learn the skills to help keep power plants running safely and efficiently. You'll receive training in boiler operations, maintenance techniques and tool use through classroom learning, hands-on labs and a work practicum. You'll also be prepared to write the provincial licensing exams.

THIRD CLASS: Build on your Fourth Class foundation and gain the skills to lead the operation and maintenance of the complex systems used in industrial boilers, pumps, air conditioning and refrigeration systems. You'll also be prepared to write the provincial licensing exams.

AFTER GPC: Work as a power engineer or process operator in plants, large-scale buildings, mills and mines.

LEARN ON STATE-OF-THE-ART EQUIPMENT AND COMPLETE ONE-OF-A-KIND PROJECTS THAT WILL PREPARE YOU FOR A CAREER IN THE WELDING TRADE.

You will receive hands-on training in multiple welding processes, operating fabrication equipment, using blueprints, general shop practices and shop safety. Before you graduate, you will have the opportunity to take the CWB test. Your welding certificate may give you credit for Level 1 and Level 2 apprenticeship training as well as 600 hours of trade time credit. You will only need Level 3 training and sufficient work hours to write the interprovincial journeyman exam – your ticket to working as a journeyman welder anywhere in Canada.

AFTER GPC: Work as a self-employed contractor, in a private welding shop or for a manufacturer. Continue your apprenticeship and earn your journeyman status to increase your earning potential.

You can take your first year (and sometimes more) of almost any University of Regina or University of Saskatchewan program right here at Great Plains College. Most classes are face-to-face, with less than 35 people per class. You can also maximize your scholarship potential by qualifying for scholarships at both the university you are enrolled at and Great Plains College.

COMPLETE THE 10 PRE-PROFESSIONAL COURSES YOU NEED TO APPLY TO THE UNIVERSITY OF SASKATCHEWAN (USASK) COLLEGE OF NURSING AT GREAT PLAINS COLLEGE SWIFT CURRENT CAMPUS.

The four-year USask undergraduate nursing program requires the first year of studies to be a pre-professional year followed by three years of nursing education leading to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN).

CLASSES START: September or January

LOCATION: Swift Current

AFTER GPC: Your completed pre-professional year will give you the credits you need to apply to the USask College of Nursing. Upon acceptance you may complete years two, three and four of your Bachelor of Science in Nursing at the Swift Current Campus or another USask Nursing site. The pre-professional year can also transfer to other health science degrees at USask.

IN THE UNIVERSITY OF SASKATCHEWAN’S BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (BSN) PROGRAM, YOU WILL LEARN ALL ASPECTS OF HEALTH AND WELL-BEING ACROSS A PERSON’S LIFE SPAN. YOU WILL STUDY NURSING, HEALTH AND THE HEALTH-CARE SYSTEMS THROUGH THE CREATION AND INTEGRATION OF KNOWLEDGE FROM RESEARCH, EDUCATION AND PRACTICE.

You will participate in theory courses, evidence-based research, and nursing practice in simulation, lab and clinical settings. The BSN program includes access to clinical practice opportunities in hospitals and community agencies.

LOCATION: Swift Current

AFTER GPC: Upon completion of the USask Bachelor of Science in Nursing you will be prepared to write the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN) exam. Successful completion of BSN degree, the NCLEX-RN exam and registration with a provincial regulatory body (College of Registered Nurses of Saskatchewan) will allow you to work as a Registered Nurse (RN) in Saskatchewan.

Our Adult 10 and CAEC (former GED) programs are for students who haven’t completed high school. You’ll have the chance to complete high school credits or work on completing the five tests necessary to earn your CAEC diploma. Both programs will also give you new tools to improve your life outside of school and arm you with industry certificates to improve your chance of getting the job you want.

CLASSES START: Varies by location. Visit greatplainscollege.ca/adult10 for dates.

LOCATIONS: Kindersley, Maple Creek, Martensville

AFTER GPC: Graduating from this program means you might move into the Grade 12 program, apply to enter some post-secondary courses or get a job. The choice is yours!

MANY EMPLOYERS AND POST-SECONDARY PROGRAMS REQUIRE THE MINIMUM STANDING OF A COMPLETE HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION. LET’S HELP YOU GET THERE.

We offer complete credits for a Grade 12 standing recognized by the Ministry of Education. No matter how long you’ve been out of a school setting, our instructors are here to help you transition and prepare for all that Grade 12 programming entails. This program also provides opportunities for individuals who have completed high school and wish to upgrade specific classes.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Complete and submit an electronic or paper application form which is available online at **greatplainscollege.ca/apply**, or stop in at any Great Plains College location.

Remember to pay your application fee and submit your most current official transcripts for your application to be considered.

WHEN SHOULD I APPLY?

For most programs, applications are accepted year-round on a first come-first served basis. Apply early to secure your seat.

Don't forget to apply by April 30 (for September program start dates), October 31 (for late fall or winter program start dates), or February 28 (for spring program start dates) to be considered for an Entrance Scholarship.

Please note the Practical Nursing programs have application deadlines.

OK, I'VE APPLIED. NOW WHAT?

A student adviser will contact you shortly to confirm that we have received your application. You may receive a conditional acceptance letter outlining program, tuition and scholarship details. If you are conditionally accepted, you will be asked to pay a tuition deposit within 30 days to secure your seat.

If you apply to a program that is already full, or have not met your program's prerequisites, a student adviser will contact you to discuss your options.
