



WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

The Adult 10 and CAEC (former GED) programs are for students who haven't completed high school. You will have the opportunity to complete high school credits or prepare to write the five tests needed to earn your CAEC credential. You will improve your ability to work with numbers, communicate, read and write.

In addition to academic studies, you will also participate in a number of employment and life-skills lessons. Our staff and instructors know that sometimes life's up and downs can get in the way of education. That is why we will meet you wherever you are at and work with you to create the learning plan that meets your needs.

FINANCIAL AID

This program is not eligible for Entrance Scholarships, however Adult Basic Education Persistence Awards of \$750-\$1,500 (8 total) are available to recognize students who've demonstrated perseverance in order to continue with their formal education.

CAEC

The CAEC (former GED) program will help you prepare to write the five tests necessary to obtain the CAEC credential, which include:

- Reading
- Writing
- Mathematics
- Science
- Social Studies

Graduating from this program means you might move into obtaining grade 12 credits, apply to enter post-secondary programs, get a job or obtain better employment.
