



WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Grade 12 Program:

In an adult-focused learning environment, you will complete the credits required to earn a Grade 12 standing recognized by the Ministry of Education. Core subject areas include English, Canadian Studies, Mathematics, Science, and 30-level electives needed for graduation.

Canadian Adult Education Credential (CAEC):

The CAEC is a high school equivalency credential recognized across Canada. You will prepare to write five tests in Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. The CAEC also meets the language requirement for select post-secondary programs.

Upgrading:

The Adult Basic Education program also supports individuals who have already completed high school.

If you left high school before graduating, need additional credits or higher grades, or completed high school outside of Canada, upgrading may be the right option. Many post secondary-programs require specific courses and grades, which can be completed through our Grade 12 classrooms.

Our programs are designed for adult learners and provide a supportive environment to help you achieve your educational and career goals.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) Level 4
- Permanent Resident or Canadian Citizen

FEES & FINANCIAL AID

Tuition: FREE
Application Fee: \$75

Transportation will be provided from Saskatoon to Warman and return.

This program is not eligible for Entrance Scholarships, however Adult Basic Education Persistence Awards of \$750-\$1,500 (2 total) are available to recognize students who've demonstrated perseverance in order to continue with their formal education.
