Do you enjoy helping others and are looking for a rewarding career with opportunities for growth? The Newcomer Essential Skills: Introduction to Continuing Care Assistant program prepares you for employment in the healthcare sector while creating a pathway to further education.

Through this program, you will:

- Develop workplace skills for a care home setting, including teamwork, professionalism, confidence, and time management
- Strengthen English Language skills, including reading, writing, speaking, listening, medical terminology, academic writing, and communication with clients, families, and healthcare colleagues

- Earn industry certifications including CPR-C/First Aid, Professional Assault Response Training, Transferring, Lifting and Repositioning, WHMIS, Food Safe and driver training
- Earn three post-secondary course credits toward the Continuing Care Assistant program at Great Plains College or Saskatchewan Polytechnic
- Receive mentorship, coaching, and employment connections
- Gain 60 hours of Canadian work experience through a placement in a care home

Upon completion, you will be prepared to pursue employment in healthcare and continue your education in the Continuing Care Assistant field.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) Level 4
- Permanent Resident, Canadian Citizen, CUAET or Refugee Protected Person Status
- No recognized Canadian Grade 12

FEES & FINANCIAL AID

Application Fee: \$75

Transportation will be provided at no cost to the student from Saskatoon to Warman and return.

This program is not eligible for student loans consideration or Great Plains College Entrance Scholarships. However, an Adult Basic Education Persistence Award of \$750 is available to recognize a student who has demonstrated perseverance in order to continue with a formal education
