



### WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Do you enjoy working with children and helping them learn and grow? The Essential Skills for Newcomers: Early Childhood Education program prepares you for employment in the early learning sector while creating a pathway to further education.

Through this program, you will:

- Develop workplace skills such as teamwork, professionalism, communication, confidence, and time management
- Strengthen English Language skills, including reading, writing, speaking, and listening
- Build job search skills, including resume writing, interview preparation, and understanding Canadian workplace expectations

- Earn industry tickets and certifications including CPR-C/First Aid, Teacher Talk, Respect in the Workplace, Food Safe, WHMIS and driver training
- Receive mentorship, coaching, and employment support
- Earn your Early Childhood Education Level 1 certification by successfully completing three Early Childhood Education courses
- Gain 60 hours of Canadian work experience through a placement in an early learning centre

Upon completion, you will be prepared to pursue employment in the early learning and childcare sector and continue your education in Early Childhood Education

### ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) Level 4
- Permanent Resident, Canadian Citizen, CUAET or Refugee Protected Person Status
- No recognized Canadian Grade 12

### FEES & FINANCIAL AID

Tuition: Free

Application Fee: \$75

Transportation will be provided at no cost to the student from Saskatoon to Warman and return.

This program is not eligible for student loans consideration or Great Plains College Entrance Scholarships. However, an Adult Basic Education Persistence Award of \$750 is available to recognize a student who has demonstrated perseverance in order to continue with formal education.
